The Northern Neck Kennel Club Of Virginia, Inc. was founded on January 3, 1989 by a local group of dog lovers, breeders and exhibitors who wished to bring organized dog-related activities to the Northern Neck of Virginia.

Club Information Sheet

PURPOSE

1. To encourage and promote quality in the breeding of registered purebred dogs and to do all possible to bring their natural abilities to perfection;
2. To urge members and breeders to accept the standard of the breed as approved by The American Kennel Club as the only standard of excellence by which registered purebred dogs shall be judged;
3. To protect and advance the interests of registered purebred dogs by encouraging sportsmanlike competition at dog shows, obedience trials, and licensed hunt tests;
4. To conduct sanction and licensed purebred shows and obedience trails and matches under the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club or the North American Hunting Retriever Association;
5. To do all in its power to encourage and promote responsible dog ownership through obedience classes, educational seminars, and community-based programs designed to expand public awareness of proper dog care and responsible dog ownership.

MEMBERSHIP: The Northern Neck Kennel Club is looking for serious-minded dog breeders, exhibitors, handlers, and other dog professionals (veterinarians, kennel operators, groomers etc) and ALL dog lovers (including owners of mixed breeds) who are committed to the goals and objectives of the Club. There is no requirement for dog ownership or for residence in the Northern Neck area. Associate membership is available for those who are unable to participate, but who support our efforts.

Individual Memberships are \$20; Family Memberships are \$30; Associate Memberships (non-voting) are \$15; and Junior Memberships (under age 18) are \$10.

PROGRAMS & COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: The Northern Neck Kennel Club offers community-based programs designed to expand public awareness and knowledge. These programs include: AKC Conformation Shows, Matches, Obedience Classes, Handling Classes, Agility Classes and training, Freestyle Classes, Therapy Dog International Testing, Canine Good Citizenship Tests, Pet Education Programs for children (which promote responsible dog ownership), Therapy Dog visits to many locations, educational seminars which include workshops by professional handlers, trainers and breeders. MEETINGS: Unless otherwise announced, regular meetings are held on the second Monday night of each OTHER month (January onwards) at 7.00pm at the Lancaster Community Library on School Street in Kilmarnock VA. Details of meetings are announced on the Club website www.northernneckkennelclub.com, in the local press, by email to members, and in the bi-monthly Newsletter. The January meeting every year is a dinner meeting held at a local restaurant.
